How does E→O75 compare to other hair removal methods?

With E→O75 we can treat large areas of the body much quicker and without the pain associated with waxing and electrolysis. Waxing is painful and the hair has to be a certain length to be effective, skin reactions and ingrown hairs are common. Electrolysis is a very slow process and is hair by hair and can be painful and cause scarring. E→O75 is faster more convenient and reduces ingrown hair and skin reactions.

Is E→O75 Safe?

The treatment is individually prescribed according to customers needs, taking the body area into account, the customers skin type as well as the hair being treated. The machine is used by over 40,000 operators in France and is already a household name.

Is E→O75 permanent hair removal?

The advertising standards agency prevents anyone from saying permanent hair removal, however we can say that we offer 'permanent hair reduction'. After the first treatment the client will experience significant reduction in the density of the hair and subsequent re-growth is lighter and finer. It is important to mention to the customer that IPL treatment does encourage the hairs to move into the anagen 'growing' stage so it may appear to the customer that there is re-growth when in fact what they are experiencing is synchronised hair growth making the following treatments optimised for success.

How many treatments will I need and what results can I expect?

We recommend a course of 6-8 treatments initially and thereafter the customer may wish to have one or two top up treatments per year. Hair will become lighter and finer and more vellus like.

Who can be treated?

The treatment works with the melanin in the hair so as long as the hair is dark or has a dark root it can be treated. Conversely white hair, grey hair, red hair (pheo-melanin) cannot be treated. Blond hair is more challenging than dark hair but as long as there is melanin in the hair and the root is dark it can be treated. It is also important to remember that melanin is found in the skin which is why it is important to treat darker skinned clients and tanned clients with less intensity to avoid heat build up in the skin. Black skins cannot be treated.

How does the treatment work?

The IPL light is attracted to the melanin in the hair. As long as there is melanin in the hair the treatment will be effective. A water based gel, similar to ultrasound gel is applied to the skin to optimise the treatment. The IPL is applied to the skin and light energy passes through the applicator and is absorbed by the hair causing a heat reaction and destroying the follicle.

Tell me about E→O75 in a nutshell

E→O75 is a light based hair removal system that safely and effectively reduces unwanted hair. For best results a course of 6-8 treatments is required with intervals of 4-6 weeks on facial areas and 6-8 weeks on body areas. During a consultation we will offer a patch test which determines eligibility for treatment. Hair is required in the area prior to treatment so other methods of hair removal should be avoided for 30 days prior to treatment. Also Sun beds, sunlight and fake tan should be avoided for 30 days before and after the treatment. After each treatment the re-growth will be lighter and finer and less noticeable. After a course of treatment has been undertaken, top up treatments can maintain results once or twice per year.
